

Senior Housing Guidelines

Must be 60 years of age or older.

PRIORITY:

- A. Big Piney, Marbleton and LaBarge seniors have first priority to available housing.
- B. Long time Sublette County seniors have presidency over other applicants.
- C. Parents of Big Piney, Marbleton Residence will have the next option to apply.
- D. All other seniors 60 years old and older will then be considered.
- E. Handicap or Special-need persons will be considered.

The senior housing board reserves the right to perform credit or background checks on any or all applicants.

If applicant is related to a Sublette County resident the resident must be a resident of the county for at least 2 years.

Those applicants who do not have family who live in Sublette County or they are coming from outside the county will be given second choice if units are available.

The housing board will make all decisions of who will get to lease a unit. The board will follow the underlying priorities in making its decision. The board of directors may also consider need base, time a person has been on the waiting list, and other factors in making the final determination.
